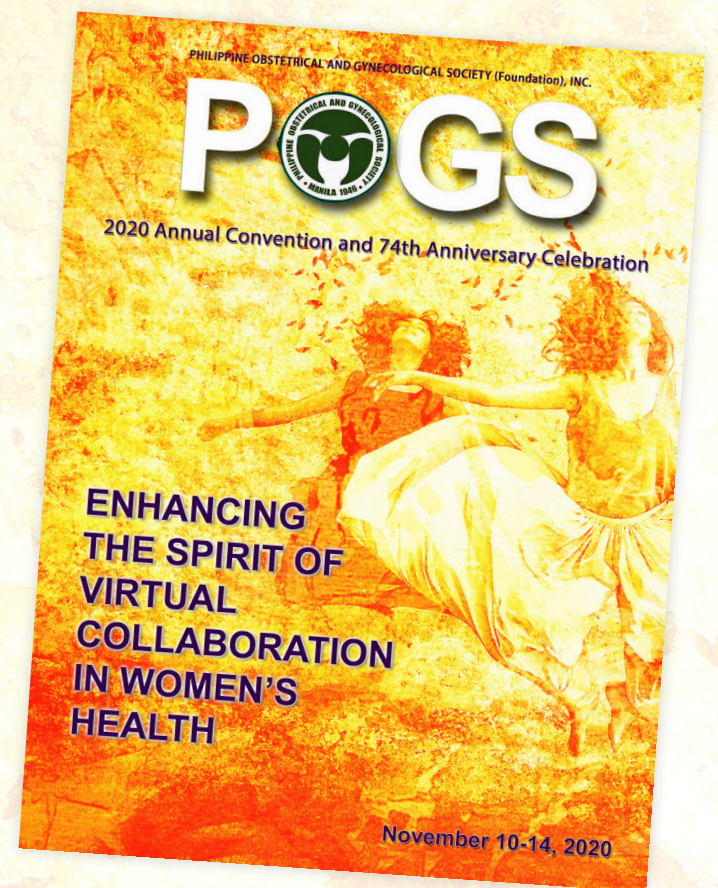

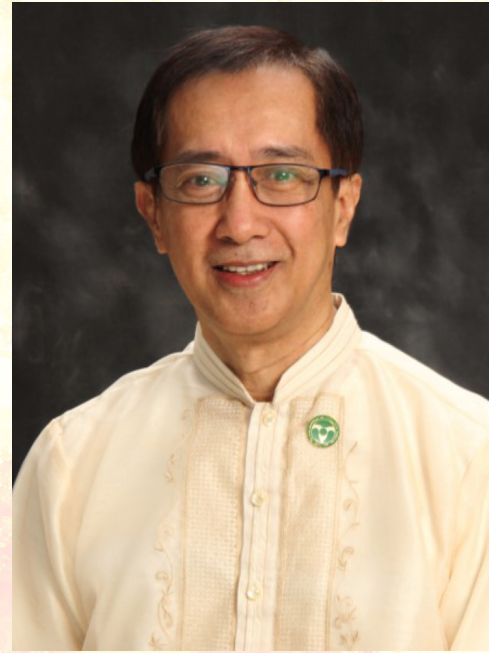

The Candlelight Ceremony

More than 70 years ago, before the Society was formed, there was no marked sign of direction in the leadership of Obstetrics and Gynecology until July 6, 1946 when the POGS was born through the efforts of 24 energetic members and pioneering physicians.

The first candlelight ceremony was held in 1985 during the Presidency of **Dr. Erlinda Germar**. The lighting of the candle for new Fellows was initiated by the Chair of the Committee on Credentials and Membership, **Dr. Rosendo R. Roque**, Past President in 2004. The first ever recipient of the lighted candle was **Dr. Lyra Ruth C. Chua**, now a Past President of POGS. At that time, the Board Secretary, Dr. Rosendo Roque explained what it means to be a POGS fellow. In total darkness, each and every word etched its meaning to the Fellow inductees at that time. Dr. Erlinda Germar lighted the single candle and made its way to where Dr. Lyra Chua was standing and lit her candle, urging her then to pass on the light to the person next to her and so on down the line.

This candlelight ceremony is done every year during the induction of new fellows into the society. All lights in the hall will be turned off, and a POGS Past President will light the big candle from which the first inductee will symbolically derive the light and which will be passed on to his/her colleagues. A message of welcome to the new fellows is given after which the POGS President officially welcomes and administers the oath of induction to the new fellows.
